

STAY ON TRACK

Medication & Vet Visit Tracker

When your dog is on medication, it's easy to second-guess yourself. Did I give it? Was it this morning or last night? This tracker keeps the schedule clear, so your dog gets exactly what your vet prescribed.

List each medicine with its dose and time, and check the box only after that dose is given. Never double or change a dose on your own. If you miss a dose, give too much, or notice a possible side effect, call your veterinarian right away and follow the prescription label. Different medicines require different next steps.

A few notes before your visit make the most of your time with the vet, and help you remember what they say.

⚠ ABOUT MEDICATIONS, CALL YOUR VET IF

- You missed several doses
- Symptoms get worse on the meds
- You're unsure about a dose
- Vomiting or a reaction after a dose
- A new med seems to cause trouble
- Running low, can't refill in time
